Dixie Medal

“Seeing the Elephant,” and getting involved in actual battles against human opponents, is the most difficult part of every new member’s journey in the ACWGC. It can be a challenge to find new opponents, learn all the rules, and to discover which strategies and plans to utilize in your battles. The Dixie Medal will be awarded to those officers who can stick at it and prove that they have what it takes to be a General in the Confederate States Army.

The Dixie Medal is awarded to Confederate officers when they complete and register their first five games in the Department of Records. The medal includes 10 additional OBD points for recipients.



Beauregard Medal

Playing games and having fun is what we all joined the ACWGC to do. But winning battles is really what we are all striving to accomplish in our games. This Medal recognizes those Confederate Members who rack up victories over the Yankee invaders on a consistent basis. It will take some time to earn, but it is the mark of a true fighter.

The Pierre Beauregard Medal is awarded to Confederate officers when they successfully complete and register twenty-five one-on-one battle victories in the Department of Records. This Medal will be awarded each time an officer accomplishes this feat. This Medal includes no additional OBD points for recipients.

Warrior Medal

This special Medal was forged in commemoration of former Confederate Member, Lt. Gen. Tom Phillips. Phillips completed over 1,000 games during his career with the ACWGC (2006 - 2023) and was a constant and positive influence on those around him. Phillips was constantly playing a dozen games at a time and always just enjoying the friendly competition - win or lose.

The Warrior Medal is awarded to Confederate Members each time they reach 100 completed games in the Department of Records. This medal includes 10 additional OBD points for recipients.



Stonewall Medal

"Kill them, sir. Kill every last man of them," so said Stonewall Jackson when asked how the war might be concluded. In order for the Confederate Cause to achieve ultimate victory we must have as many major victories on the battlefield as possible. This Medal is designed to honor the most successful generals wearing the gray for their feats on the fields of battle. It is one of the hardest medals to earn for any Confederate Member during their service.

The Stonewall Medal is awarded to Confederate officers when they reach 100 Battle Major Victories in the Department of Records. The medal includes 20 additional OBD points for recipients and may be won multiple times.



Brotherhood Medal

The games we play are often more enjoyable when played as part of a team. The ability to put the needs of the team above your own when playing in a Multiplayer Game is often the key to being a successful team player. This Medal rewards those who are always willing to join their brothers and go to war against the Yankee scoundrels.

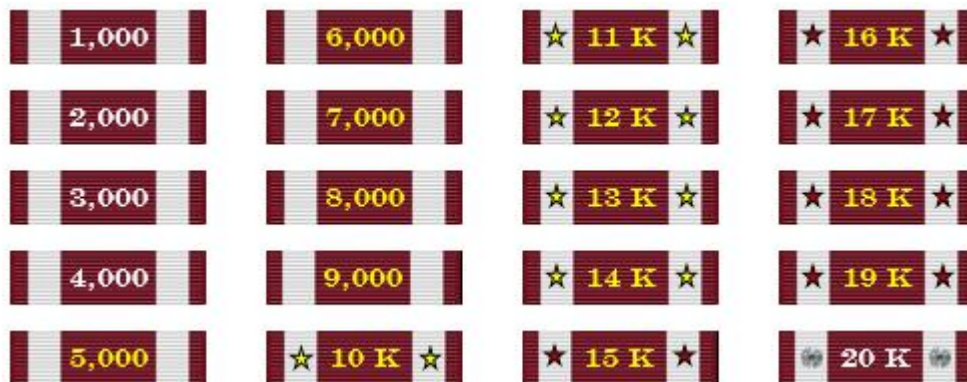
The Brotherhood Medal is awarded to Confederates Members when they complete ten Multiplayer Games and register them in the DOR. This Medal includes an additional 10 OBD points for recipients. The medal may be won multiple times.



John Dragan Medal

This medal is named after the ACWGC's all-time Confederate leader in accumulated points, Gen. John Dragan. During his 18-year career in our Club (2003 - 2021), John Dragan accumulated a total of 12,281.94 points and completed an astounding 1,081 games with 32,000 turns played. John Dragan passed away in 2021 but is remembered through the awarding of this Medal.

The John Dragan Medal is awarded to Confederate Members each time they accumulate 1,000 OBD Points in the Department of Records. This Medal includes no additional OBD points for recipients.



Deo Vindice Medal

Deo Vindice became the motto of the Confederacy and was printed on many official documents and seals. It means, "With God, our Defender" or "Under God as our Vindicator." The best way to win any war is to fight the enemy consistently and without mercy in order to wear them down. That is how we will beat the Yankees in the ACWGC.

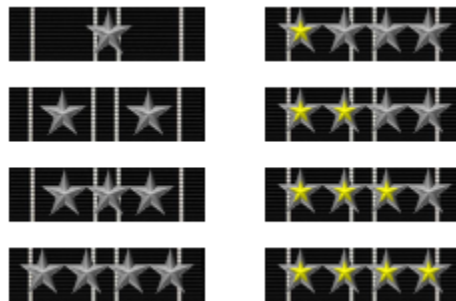
The Deo Vindice Medal is awarded to Confederate Members who complete at least 50 games in a calendar year. This medal is awarded with 20 OBD points and may be won numerous times during an officer's career.



Wizard Medal

Some men, like Nathan Bedford Forrest, were born to be soldiers. These men are always looking for more battles to fight and never seem to tire of the chaos of war. Our Club has its fair share of extremely active officers and their constant warmaking is what makes the ACWGC such a fun place to play. This medal is meant to recognize our most active gamers wearing the gray.

The Wizard Medal is awarded to Confederate officers who complete at least 1,000 turns in a calendar year. This medal is awarded with 20 OBD points and may be won numerous times during an officer's career.



Kunz Medal

The ACWGC is filled with good people who all share a love of gaming and history. But learning how to play these games and conduct a PBEM battle does not come naturally to many new recruits. We all need someone to help us out as we get started and to answer our questions. Volunteer officers at the Advanced Training Academy (formerly the Vicksburg Military Academy) have spent countless hours helping to train the new generation of Confederate officers year after year. This medal is named for our most famous instructor at the academy - Gen. Nick Kunz.

The Kunz Medal is awarded to Confederate instructors who train a total of five new Confederate officers. This medal is awarded with 10 OBD points and may be won up to five times in an officer's career.



Honor Guard Medal

The Confederacy is lucky to have many excellent leaders holding positions as either divisional, corps, or army commanders. Without these fine officers doing their part to make the Club work it would all fall apart.

The Honor Guard Medal is awarded to unit commanders, above the level of brigade command, for meritorious service in the execution of their duties. Officers deserving such an honor may be recommended for the Medal by either their army commander or the General in Chief. Recipients of the Honor Guard Medal will receive 10 OBD points. The Medal may be awarded three times.



Robert E. Lee Medal

The Confederate side of the ACWGC is blessed to have many great members. From time to time we stop and recognize those amongst us who have gone above and beyond the call of duty for their fellow Confederates. This special medal honors those members whose contributions make our lives more enjoyable in the ACWGC.

The Robert E. Lee Medal is awarded to Confederate officers who go above and beyond the normal call of duty for the Confederacy. The medal includes 20 additional OBD points for recipients. The Medal may be awarded five times.



Patrick Cleburne Medal

Playing and completing turns is the building block of every game we play in this Club. Whether you win or lose it all starts when you play turns and engage opponents. This medal honors those who continue to play games and accumulate turns year after year.

The Patrick Cleburne Medal is awarded to officers who register a total of 5,000 turns in the Department of Records. This medal comes with 10 OBD points and may be won multiple times.



Confederate Legend Medal

If the Confederacy had a Hall of Fame, then the recipients of this medal would have their plaques hanging up for all to see. This medal honors those whose long service to the Club, through any combination of gaming and admin points, has helped them to accumulate 5,000 or more OBD points. It is a rare medal to see awarded in the Confederacy and takes years of hard work and dedication to earn.

The Confederate Legend Medal is awarded to Confederate officers who reach the 5,000-point plateaus. The medal includes no additional OBD points for recipients. It may be won multiple times at every 5,000-point increment.
